7 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC
8 SERVICE TO EXECUTE A MODIFICATION OF CONTRACT NO.
9 7424 WITH CHAGRIN VALLEY PAVING, INC, AND DECLARING
10 AN EMERGENCY.

12 WHEREAS, under the authority of Ordinance 85-2016 the City, after competitive
13 bidding, entered into Contract No. 7424 with Chagrin Valley Paving, Inc., for the purposes
14 of executing the 2017 Utility Patch Program; and

15
16 WHEREAS, it is necessary to adjust the unit quantities of labor and material in the
17 contract beyond what was originally estimated, in order to meet the needs of the City in
18 executing the 2017 Utility Patch Program, which will increase the estimated total contract
19 price by an amount not exceeding \$70,000.00.

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls,
22 County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

24 Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to execute a modification
25 of Contract No. 7424 with Chagrin Valley Paving, Inc., to increase the unit quantities of
26 labor and material as necessary in the opinion of the Director of Public Service, but not to
27 exceed an amount \$70,000.00 over the original estimated contract price.

28
29 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed pay invoices for
30 work based upon the Contract as modified, in an amount not to exceed \$70,000.00 over the
31 original estimated contract price, from the Water and Sewer Funds, Line Item Other
32 Operations. Furthermore, the Director of Finance is hereby authorized to increase
33 appropriations in the Water and Sewer Funds, line item Other Operations by \$35,000 each
34 and reduce appropriations in the Water and Sewer Funds, line item Capital Outlay by the
35 same.

37 Section 3. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and
38 resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions
39 or portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not
40 previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

42 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning
43 and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this
44 Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted
45 in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal
46 requirements including, to the extent applicable, Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

48 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary
49 for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City
50 of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote
51 of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in
52 force at the earliest period allowed by law.


