7 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC
8 SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR EMPLOYMENT
9 AGENCY SERVICES RELATED TO SEASONAL AND
10 OCCASIONAL EMPLOYEES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

12 BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit, and State
13 of Ohio, that:

14
15 Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract
16 according to law for the purchase of the City's requirements for employment agency services
17 including recruitment, selection, placement and payroll services in relation to seasonal and
18 occasional employees, for period of one year with an option to renew for one additional year.



20 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby directed to make payment for same out of
21 various City funds appropriated therefor.



23 Section 3. Any ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions
24 inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent
25 herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

27 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and
28 relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that
29 all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were
30 in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107
31 of the Codified Ordinances.



33 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the
34 preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga
35 Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the
36 members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its
37 passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest
38 period allowed by law.
