8 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC
9 SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS
10 ACCORDING TO LAW WITH THE CITY OF AKRON TO PROVIDE
11 FOR WATER SHARING AND TAX SHARING, AND DECLARING AN
12 EMERGENCY

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of
15 Summit and State of Ohio:

16
17 Section 1. That the Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or
18 contracts according to law to provide for water sharing and tax sharing with the City of Akron in
19 substantial conformity with the drafts on file with the Clerk of Council.

21 Section 2. That any other ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions
22 inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent
23 herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

25 Section 3. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning
26 and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and
27 that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
28 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107
29 of the Codified Ordinances.

30
31 Section 4. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for
32 the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga
33 Falls and the inhabitants thereof, for the reason that it is immediately necessary to permit timely and
34 appropriate development of this property, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two thirds of
35 the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its
36 passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period
37 allowed by law.
