7 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC  
8 SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS,  
9 ACCORDING TO LAW, FOR THE PURCHASE OF CERTAIN  
10 SUPPLIES AND MATERIALS FOR USE BY THE STREET  
11 DEPARTMENT DURING 2007, AND DECLARING AN  
12 EMERGENCY.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County  
15 of Summit and State of Ohio:

16  
17 Section 1. That the Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or  
18 contracts, according to law, for the purchase of the following supplies and materials for use by  
19 the Street Department during 2007, to-wit:

- 21 Rock salt
- 22 Rock Salt Conveyoring
- 23 Asphaltic products
- 24 Sign Materials
- 25


26 Section 2. That the Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make payment  
27 for same from the SCMR Fund, line item Other Operations; State Highway Improvement Fund,  
28 line item Other Operations; Capital Projects Fund, line item Capital Outlay; and Motor Vehicle  
29 License Tax Fund, line item Other Operations.

30  
31 Section 3. That any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and  
32 resolutions inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and  
33 resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have  
34 not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

35  
36 Section 4. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning  
37 and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council  
38 and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal  
39 action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including  
40 Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.



42 Section 5. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for  
43 the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of  
44 Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof for the reason that the supplies are necessary for the  
45 daily functioning of the Street Department, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of  
46 two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force  
47 immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in  
48 force at the earliest period allowed by law.
