7 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF  
8 PUBLIC SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR  
9 CONTRACTS, ACCORDING TO LAW, FOR THE  
10 PURCHASE OF THE CITY'S REQUIREMENTS FOR  
11 CERTAIN MATERIALS, SUPPLIES, AND EQUIPMENT  
12 FOR USE BY THE ELECTRIC DIVISION DURING  
13 2015, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

15 BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of  
16 Summit and State of Ohio, that:

18 Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a  
19 contract or contracts, according to law, for the purchase of the City's  
20 requirements for the following materials, supplies, and equipment for use by  
21 the Electric Division during 2015:

32 Notwithstanding and as an exception to Section 181.06 of the Codified  
33 Ordinances, expenditures made under the contracts authorized by this  
34 ordinance shall not exceed, in the aggregate, \$977,100, without further consent  
35 of City Council by ordinance or resolution.

36  
37 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to  
38 make payment for same from the Electric Fund, line items Other Operations  
39 and Capital Outlay.

41 Section 3. Any other ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and  
42 resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and  
43 resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been  
44 repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

46 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council  
47 concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open  
48 meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any  
49 committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the  
50 public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the  
51 Codified Ordinances.

Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
