7 ORDINANCE NO. 76 - 2016

9 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE TRAFFIC CONTROL  
10 FILE BY PROVIDING FOR INSTALLATION OF VARIOUS  
11 TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES, AND DECLARING AN  
12 EMERGENCY.

13  
14 WHEREAS, site-specific traffic control regulations of the City are established and  
15 maintained in the "Traffic Control File," a document established and maintained by the  
16 Chief of Police pursuant to Chapter 305 of the Codified Ordinances, and

17  
18 WHEREAS, Section 305.02 of said Chapter requires that amendments to the Traffic  
19 Control File be made only through legislation passed by City Council.

20  
21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls,  
22 County of Summit, and State of Ohio, that:

23  
24 Section 1. Upon the recommendation of the Traffic Committee, the Traffic Control  
25 File is hereby amended as follows:

- 26  
27 1. Change the speed limit on State Road from 45 mph to 35 mph between  
28 Quick Road and the northern City limits.  
29 2. Add the following streets as designated truck routes under Codified  
30 Ordinance 339.02:  
31 Steels Corners Road - Eastern Corporation Limit westerly to State Road  
32 only  
33 Wyoga Lake Road  
34 Seasons Road  
35 Marc Drive  
36 Remington Road  
37 Cavalier Trail  
38 3. Add signage designating bike lanes on Chart Road from State Road to  
39 Northampton Road and along Front Street from Broad Boulevard to Prospect  
40 Street.  
41 4. Prohibit parking on Front Street 100 feet south of Sacket on the west side of  
42 the street.  
43

44 Section 2. The Chief of Police is hereby authorized and directed to note in the  
45 Traffic Control File the proper legends.

46  
47 Section 3. The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to cause the installation  
48 or removal of the proper signage reflecting the above amendments.

50 Section 4. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and  
51 resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed but any ordinances and  
52 resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and  
53 which have not been previously repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

55        Section 5. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council  
56 concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open  
57 meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its  
58 committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in  
59 compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified  
60 Ordinances.

61  
62        Section 6. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure  
63 necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and  
64 welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof and provided it  
65 receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to  
66 Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval  
67 by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed  
68 by law.


