8 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A
9 COOPERATIVE PROCUREMENT AGREEMENT WITH SOURCING ALLIANCE
10 NETWORK, WAIVING COMPETITIVE BIDDING FOR THE PURCHASE OF
11 PRODUCTS, SERVICES, MATERIALS AND SUPPLIES PURCHASED
12 THROUGH COOPERATIVE PURCHASE AGREEMENTS ADMINISTERED BY
13 SOURCING ALLIANCE NETWORK, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

16 WHEREAS, Section 2 of the City Charter, adopted pursuant to Art. XVIII, Sections 3 and 7 of the Ohio
17 Constitution, authorizes this Council to make exception to the competitive bidding procedures set forth in the
18 Revised Code.

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and
21 State of Ohio, that:



23 Section 1. Notwithstanding and as an exception to the competitive bidding requirements set forth in Title
24 7 and elsewhere in the Ohio Revised Code, the Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with
25 Sourcing Alliance Network, for the purpose of establishing membership in Sourcing Alliance Network, and for
26 the further purpose of purchasing products, services, materials and supplies through cooperative purchase
27 agreements administered by Sourcing Alliance Network. Competitive bidding requirements which would
28 otherwise be associated with such purchases are hereby waived.


30 Section 2. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent
31 herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions not
32 inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.
33

34 Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the
35 passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this
36 Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in
37 compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.


39 Section 4. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation
40 of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants
41 thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to
42 Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise
43 it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
