7 AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR SUPPLEMENTAL
8 APPROPRIATIONS OF MONEY FOR OPERATIONAL
9 EXPENDITURES OF THE CITY OF CUYAHOGA FALLS FROM
10 THE GENERAL FUND, CIVIL SERVICE DEPARTMENT, AND
11 DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

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13 WHEREAS, Article VI, Sections 7 and 8 of the City Charter provide that City Council may
14 revise, amend, and supplement budgetary appropriations during the fiscal year, and may
15 authorize the transfer of unencumbered appropriations within various accounts, and

16
17 WHEREAS, the funds are needed due to the unforeseen costs associated with the Fire
18 Lieutenant promotional examination.

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20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County
21 of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

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23 Section 1. Moneys are hereby appropriated from the un-appropriated fund balances of the
24 departments or divisions as set forth as follows:

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27 Section 2. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions
28 inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions or portions of
29 ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been
30 repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

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32 Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and
33 relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and
34 that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal
35 action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including
36 Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

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38 Section 4. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the
39 preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga
40 Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the
41 members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its
42 passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest
43 period allowed by law.
