ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS TO PURCHASE PROPERTY LOCATED AT 1911 DWIGHT STREET AND 138 GRAHAM ROAD, MAKING AN APPROPRIATION THEREFOR, AND TO ACCEPT GRANT FUNDS FROM THE SUMMIT COUNTY LAND REUTILIZATION FOR THE PURCHASE OF THE PROPERTIES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the residential structures located at 1911 Dwight Street and 138 Graham Road, Cuyahoga Falls, Ohio ("Properties") sustained catastrophic damage as a result of the May 12th, 2014 storm; and

WHEREAS, the City applied for and was awarded funds from the Discretionary Grant Fund Program administered by the Summit County Land Reutilization Corporation ("SCLRC") for activities such as the acquisition and demolition of the Properties; and

WHEREAS, the purchase of the Properties will prevent foreclosure, thereby causing a blight and negatively impacting neighborhood property values.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or contracts for the purchase of property located on 1911 Dwight Street (Parcel #0204846) and 138 Graham Road (Parcel #0206119).

Section 2. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to accept grant funds from the Summit County Land Reutilization Corporation for the purposes set forth in the grant application and grant agreement.

Section 3. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make payment and increase appropriations in the Storm Drainage Utility Fund, Line Item Capital Outlay, in the amount of \$190,000.

Section 4. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portion of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 5. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

Section 6. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force
