8 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC
9 SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITHOUT COMPETITIVE
10 BIDDING WITH WEATHERPROOFING TECHNOLOGIES, INC., FOR
11 PARTIAL ROOF REPLACEMENT AT THE MUNICIPAL BUILDING,
12 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

14 WHEREAS, Section 2 of the City Charter, adopted pursuant to Art. XVIII, Sections 3 and 7 of the
15 Ohio Constitution, authorizes this Council to make exception to the competitive bidding procedures
16 set forth in the Revised Code,
17

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of
19 Summit and State of Ohio, that:
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21 Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract without
22 competitive bidding with Weatherproofing Technologies Inc., for partial roof replacement at the
23 Municipal Building.


25 Section 2. The Director of Finance is authorized and directed to make payment for same from
26 the Capital Projects Fund.

28 Section 3. Any other ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions
29 inconsistent herewith hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith
30 and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.


32 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and
33 relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that
34 all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were
35 in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent applicable,
36 including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.


38 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the
39 preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga
40 Falls and the inhabitants thereof, for the reason that it is immediately necessary to permit timely and
41 appropriate development of this property, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two thirds of
42 the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its
43 passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period
44 allowed by law.
