7 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR THE
8 REPAYMENT OF MONIES TO THE U.S. DEPARTMENT
9 OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT FOR
10 ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT LOAN ACTIVITIES
11 DEEMED TO BE INELIGIBLE, AND DECLARING AN
12 EMERGENCY.
13

14 WHEREAS, the City of Cuyahoga Falls receives an annual allocation of
15 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds to be used in accordance with
16 Title 24 of the Code of Federal Regulations, Part 570; and
17

18 WHEREAS, in 2012 USO Realty and BEI Industries received CDBG funds in the
19 form of economic development loans in the amount of \$80,000 each for the purpose
20 of creating jobs to be made available to low-to-moderate income people; and
21

22 WHEREAS, the loan repayment terms are still being met; and
23

24 WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development performed
25 an audit and found a significant lack of required documentation for these loans and
26 the activities were subsequently deemed ineligible; and
27

28 WHEREAS, upon repayment of activities deemed ineligible, the U.S. Department
29 of Housing and Urban Development will increase the Community Development Block
30 Grant funds available to the City of Cuyahoga Falls for eligible activities.

32 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga
33 Falls, County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:
34

35 Section 1. The City of Cuyahoga Falls is required to repay funds to the U.S.
36 Department of Housing and Urban Development for ineligible activities.
37

38 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized to increase
39 appropriations in the General Fund, Community Development, line item Other
40 Operations by \$160,000 and to make payment for the same from the General Fund,
41 Community Development, line item Other Operations. The Director of Finance is
42 hereby authorized to increase appropriations in the Community Development Block
43 Grant, line item Other Operations by \$160,000.

45 Section 3. Any other ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and
46 resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and
47 resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed
48 are hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent applicable, including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
