9 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER  
10 INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS, WITHOUT  
11 COMPETITIVE BIDDING, WITH STANDARD INSURANCE  
12 COMPANY FOR THE CITY'S GROUP LIFE INSURANCE FOR  
13 EMPLOYEES AND RETIREES, AND DECLARING AN  
14 EMERGENCY.

15  
16 BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and  
17 State of Ohio, that:

18  
19 Section 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or contracts, without  
20 competitive bidding, with Standard Insurance Company for the City's group life insurance for  
21 employees and retirees for a period not to exceed three years.

22  
23 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized to make payment from the Self-  
24 Insurance Fund, line item Other Operations.

25  
26 Section 3. Any other ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions  
27 inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not  
28 inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and  
29 confirmed.

30  
31 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning  
32 and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this  
33 Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted  
34 in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal  
35 requirements, to the extent applicable, including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

36  
37 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for  
38 the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of  
39 Cuyahoga Falls, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members  
40 elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its  
41 passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the  
42 earliest period allowed by law.
