8 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, AS
9 DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY, TO ENTER INTO A
10 CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS, WITHOUT COMPETITIVE
11 BIDDING, WITH MOTOROLA SOLUTIONS, INC. FOR
12 THE PURCHASE OF DISPATCH CONSOLES AND
13 APPURTENANCES FOR USE IN THE DISPATCH
14 CENTER, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

17 WHEREAS, Article I, Section 2 of the City Charter, adopted pursuant to Art.
18 XVIII, Sections 3 and 7 of the Ohio Constitution, authorizes this Council to make
19 exception to the competitive bidding procedures set forth in the Revised Code; and
20

21 WHEREAS, Motorola, Inc. is the sole source purveyor of maintenance and
22 repair services for Motorola dispatch consoles and appurtenances.

24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga
25 Falls, County of Summit, and State of Ohio, that:
26

27 Section 1. The Mayor, as Director of Public Safety, is hereby authorized to
28 enter into a contract or contracts, without competitive bidding, with Motorola
29 Solutions, Inc. based upon the proposal dated October 9, 2017, for the purchase of
30 dispatch consoles and appurtenances.
31

32 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to
33 make payment for same from the Capital Projects Fund, line item Capital Outlay.
34

35 Section 3. Any ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and
36 resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and
37 resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed
38 are hereby ratified and confirmed.

40 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council
41 concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open
42 meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any
43 committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the
44 public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the
45 Codified Ordinances.

47 Section 5. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency
48 measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety,
49 convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof,

50 and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or
51 appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its
52 passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at
53 the earliest period allowed by law.
