6 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC
7 SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS,
8 ACCORDING TO LAW, FOR THE ANNUAL REQUIREMENTS OF
9 THE MUNICIPAL GARAGE FOR 2007, AND DECLARING AN
10 EMERGENCY.

13 WHEREAS, it is necessary to purchase materials, supplies and equipment for use by the
14 municipal garage on an annual basis;

15
16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County
17 of Summit and State of Ohio:

19 Section 1. That the Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or
20 contracts, according to law, for the purchase of certain materials, supplies, equipment and
21 services for use by the Garage Department during 2007:

23 Gasoline
24 Diesel Fuel
25 Oils
26 Tires
27 Towing



30 Section 2. That the Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make payment
31 for same from the Garage Fund, line item Other Operations.

33 Section 3. That any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and
34 resolutions inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and
35 resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have
36 not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

38 Section 4. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning
39 and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council
40 and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal
41 action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including
42 Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.



44 Section 5. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for
45 the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of
46 Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof for the reason that the supplies are necessary for the
47 daily functioning of the Municipal Garage, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of
48 two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force
49 immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in
50 force at the earliest period allowed by law.
