ORDINANCE NO. 9 - 2015

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DIRECTOR TO APPLY FOR AND ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT FOR A 2015 CERTIFIED LOCAL GOVERNMENT GRANT AUTHORIZING THE PAYMENT OF THE LOCAL SHARE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Ohio State Historic Preservation Office (OH SHPO) requires supporting legislation to apply for a 2015 Certified Local Government Grant, and

WHEREAS, on February 2, 2015, the City will apply for a Certified Local Government (CLG) Grant in order to assist in the completion of an Ohio Historic Inventory for the proposed Cuyahoga River Area Local Historic District, within the City of Cuyahoga Falls, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, the City of Cuyahoga Falls will use budgeted historic preservation funds in the CDBG 2014-2015 Annual Action Plan and 2014-2018 Consolidated Plan as matching share for the CLG Grant.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit, and State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. The Director of Community Development is hereby authorized to submit a CLG grant request to the OH SHPO for the completion of an Ohio Historic Inventory for the proposed Cuyahoga River Area Local Historic District.

Section 2. The Director of Community Development, and other City officials, as appropriate are hereby authorized and directed to enter into agreements that may be necessary to apply for and accept the grant mentioned herein, including the expenditure of CDBG funds as a 40% grant match.

Section 3. Any other ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent applicable, including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

53 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure
54 necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and
55 welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, for the reason
56 that it is immediately necessary to permit timely and appropriate development of
57 this property, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two thirds of the
58 members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force
59 immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take
60 effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
