5 ORDINANCE NO. 90 - 2013

7 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC  
8 SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS,  
9 ACCORDING TO LAW, FOR THE REPLACEMENT OF EXISTING 4"  
10 AND 6" WATER MAINS WITH 8" WATER MAINS IN PORTIONS OF  
11 CHESTNUT BOULEVARD, 8<sup>TH</sup> STREET AND OLIVE PLACE, AND  
12 DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

13  
14 BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and State of  
15 Ohio, that:

17 Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or  
18 contracts, according to law, for replacement of a 4" water main with an 8" water main, including all  
19 necessary appurtenances, in Chestnut Boulevard between 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Streets, and between 6<sup>th</sup> and  
20 9<sup>th</sup> Streets; replacement of a 6" water main with an 8" water main, including all necessary  
21 appurtenances, in 8<sup>th</sup> Street between Chestnut Boulevard and Grant Avenue; and replacement of a 4"  
22 water main with an 8" water main, including all necessary appurtenances, in Olive Place between  
23 Chestnut Boulevard and Grant Avenue.



25 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for same  
26 from the Water Fund, line item Capital Outlay.

27  
28 Section 3. Any other ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions  
29 inconsistent herewith hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith  
30 and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

32 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and  
33 relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that  
34 all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were  
35 in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent applicable,  
36 including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

37  
38 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the  
39 preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga  
40 Falls and the inhabitants thereof, for the reason that it is immediately necessary to permit timely and  
41 appropriate development of this property, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two thirds of  
42 the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its  
43 passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period  
44 allowed by law.
