18 BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and State of  
19 Ohio, that:

21 Section 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or contracts, through  
22 competitive bidding, with Fidelity Security Insurance Company and/or its subsidiary EyeMed Vision  
23 Care, on the basis of its final proposals dated October 13, 2015, for the professional services necessary  
24 to conduct the administration of the City's self-insured employee vision care services insurance plans,  
25 for contract periods not to exceed four years.  
26

27 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized to pay approved invoices for work based  
28 upon the Contract, from the Self-Insurance Fund.  
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30 Section 3. Any other ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions  
31 inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent  
32 herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.  
33

34 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and  
35 relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all  
36 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in  
37 meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent applicable,  
38 including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.  
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40 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the  
41 preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls,  
42 and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to  
43 Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor;  
44 otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
