7 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, AS
8 DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY, TO ENTER INTO A
9 CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS, WITHOUT
10 COMPETITIVE BIDDING, WITH MOTOROLA
11 SOLUTIONS, INC., FOR THE PURCHASE OF
12 PORTABLE RADIOS AND THE NECESSARY
13 APPURTENANCES FOR USE BY THE FIRE
14 DEPARTMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.
15

16 WHEREAS, Article I, Section 2 of the City Charter, adopted pursuant to Art.
17 XVIII, Sections 3 and 7 of the Ohio Constitution, authorizes this Council to
18 make exception to the competitive bidding procedures set forth in the Revised
19 Code; and
20

21 WHEREAS, portable digital radios are necessary for emergency
22 operations/communications; and
23

24 WHEREAS, the current radios used by the Fire Department are obsolete and
25 can no longer be repaired; and
26

27 WHEREAS, the portable radios and the necessary appurtenances sold by
28 Motorola Solutions, Inc. are the only compatible radios with existing City
29 equipment.
30

31 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of
32 Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:
33

34 Section 1. The Mayor, as Director of Public Safety, is hereby authorized to
35 enter into a contract or contracts, without competitive bidding, with Motorola
36 Solutions, Inc. for the purchase of portable digital radios and the necessary
37 appurtenances.

39 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to
40 make payment for same from the Capital Projects Fund, line item Capital
41 Outlay.

43 Section 3. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances
44 and resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances
45 and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent
46 herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and
47 confirmed.
48

49 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council
50 concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an

51 open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of
52 any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open
53 to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107
54 of the Codified Ordinances.

55

56 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure
57 necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience
58 and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and
59 provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or
60 appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its
61 passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force
62 at the earliest period allowed by law.


