8 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SERVICE DIRECTOR
9 TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT, WITHOUT COMPETITIVE
10 BIDDING, WITH MIDWEST DIRECT FOR PROCESSING
11 DAILY MAIL FOR VARIOUS DEPARTMENTS OF THE CITY,
12 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

15 BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and
16 State of Ohio, that:

18 Section 1. The Service Director is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or
19 contracts, without competitive bidding, with Midwest Direct, on the basis of its final proposal
20 dated January 16, 2015, for the professional services necessary to process daily mail for
21 various departments of the City.

23 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make payment
24 for same from funds properly appropriated to the various departments of the City for these
25 purposes, according to an apportionment of costs as between the departments.

27 Section 3. Any other ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions
28 inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not
29 inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and
30 confirmed.

32 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning
33 and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this
34 Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted
35 in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal
36 requirements, to the extent applicable, including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.
37

38 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for
39 the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of
40 Cuyahoga Falls, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members
41 elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its
42 passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the
43 earliest period allowed by law.
