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20 Section 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or contracts, without  
21 competitive bidding, with CVS Health and/or its subsidiary CVS Caremark, for the professional  
22 services necessary to conduct the administration of the City's self-insured employee prescription drug  
23 plans for a period not to exceed three years.  
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25 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized to pay approved invoices for work based  
26 upon the Contract, from the Self-Insurance Fund, line item Other Operations.  
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28 Section 3. Any other ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions  
29 inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent  
30 herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.  
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32 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating  
33 to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all  
34 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in  
35 meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent applicable,  
36 including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.  
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38 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the  
39 preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls,  
40 and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to  
41 Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor;  
42 otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
