8 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF LAW TO ENTER  
9 INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS, WITHOUT COMPETITIVE  
10 BIDDING, FOR EXPERT CONSULTING SERVICES RELATED TO  
11 PENDING FACT FINDING FOR COLLECTIVE BARGAINING, AND TO  
12 INCREASE APPROPRIATIONS IN THE GENERAL FUND, LAW  
13 DEPARTMENT, LINE ITEM OTHER OPERATIONS, BY \$30,000, AND  
14 DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

15  
16 BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and State of  
17 Ohio, that:

19 Section 1. The Director of Law is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or contracts, without  
20 competitive bidding, for expert consulting services related to pending Fact Finding for collective  
21 bargaining.



23 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for same  
24 from the General Fund, Law Department, Line Item, Other Operations and to increase appropriations  
25 in the General Fund, Law Department, Line Item Other Operations, by \$30,000.00.



27 Section 3. Any other ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions  
28 inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent  
29 herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

30  
31 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and  
32 relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all  
33 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in  
34 meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the  
35 Codified Ordinances.



37 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the  
38 preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls  
39 and the inhabitants thereof and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two thirds of the members  
40 elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and  
41 approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by  
42 law.
