5 RESOLUTION NO. 15 - 2014

7 A RESOLUTION REQUESTING "NO HEARING" RELATED TO THE
8 NEW LIQUOR PERMIT FOR SHALE GROUP LLC DBA CRAFT BEER
9 BAR, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

11 WHEREAS, Shale Group LLC DBA Craft Beer Bar (Craft Beer) previously applied for a liquor
12 permit at 1846 Front Street, Suite D, Cuyahoga Falls, Ohio and Council had no objection; and

13
14 WHEREAS, due to a change in construction plans and scheduling, Craft Beer needed to change
15 its location from Suite D to Suite G and Patio at 1846 Front Street, and

16
17 WHEREAS, although a minor change in location, the Ohio Division of Liquor Control was
18 required to issue a new notice to the City of Cuyahoga Falls, requesting response from the City
19 regarding the new liquor permit for the location at 1846 Front Street, Suite G and Patio, and

20
21 WHEREAS, Craft Beer desires to open for business on Wednesday, August 27, 2014 and must
22 have the City's response to the Ohio Division of Liquor Control prior to opening; and

24 WHEREAS, there is no need to unnecessarily delay the administrative process.

26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of
27 Summit and State of Ohio, that:

29 Section 1. This Council has no objection to the liquor permit and directs the Clerk of Council to
30 respond to the State of Ohio with a position of "no hearing requested" to assist Shale Group LLC DBA
31 Craft Beer Bar in obtaining a liquor license at the earliest possible time.

33 Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and
34 relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting to the public and in full
35 compliance with all legal requirements, including without limitations, those set forth in Section 121.22
36 of the Ohio Revised Code.

38 Section 3. This resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the
39 preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls
40 and the inhabitants thereof, for the reason that it is immediately necessary to permit timely and
41 appropriate development of this property, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two thirds of
42 the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its
43 passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period
44 allowed by law.
