12 A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE EFFORTS OF THE CELTIC CLUB
13 OF OHIO AS THEY WORK TO MAKE A POSITIVE DIFFERENCE IN
14 THE LIVES OF MANY, THROUGH LOCAL COMMUNITY SERVICE,
15 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

18 WHEREAS, 2017 will mark the Eighth Annual Celtic Club Fights Cancer/Bras Across the
19 Crooked River events; and
20

21 WHEREAS, the Celtic Club Fights Cancer/Bras Across the Crooked River events began as a way
22 to raise awareness of breast cancer and has evolved to raise awareness of all cancers; and

24 WHEREAS, since the first display in Kent in 2010, the Celtic Club has organized displays in
25 more than 30 locations in seven counties in northeast Ohio, and has donated more than 10,000
26 bras to battered women shelters; and

28 WHEREAS, the displays are meant to convey a message of hope and survival; and

30 WHEREAS, the July 6, 2016 display spanned the entire length of the 905-foot High Level Bridge
31 overlooking the Cuyahoga River Valley, in memory of Cuyahoga Falls resident John Hutchens who
32 passed away from lung cancer in 2015, and his sister Cathy Pate who passed away from breast
33 cancer in 2013. John's wife Beverly Hutchens, led a memorial service after the display was hung;

36 WHEREAS, the Celtic Club's eighth annual event will include a display across the High Level
37 Bridge in 2017 coinciding with National Breast Cancer Awareness month; and

39 WHEREAS, the volunteers of the Celtic Club Fights Cancer/Bras Across the Crooked River are
40 an example of the power of people coming together for the common good of others.

42 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of
43 Summit and State of Ohio, that:

45 Section 1. The Council hereby recognizes, thanks and supports the efforts of the Celtic Club of
46 Ohio as they work to make a positive difference in the lives of many, through local community
47 service.
48

49 Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and
50 relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that
51 all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were
52 in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of
53 the Codified Ordinances.
54

55 Section 3. This resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the
56 preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga

57 Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the
58 members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its
59 passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest
60 period allowed by law.
