Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to apply for and accept financial assistance in the form of a grant or loan from the Ohio Public Commission for the purpose of supporting the capital improvement consisting of removal and replacement of pavement, signage, light poles, and storm sewer as needed to reconstruct the roadway from Main Street to Buchholzer Boulevard, by means of the State Capital Improvement Program (SCIP) and/or Local Transportation Improvement Program (LTIP) administered by the Ohio Public Works Commission.

Section 2. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into agreements as may be necessary to apply for and accept the financial assistance mentioned herein.
