WHEREAS, the Cuyahoga River is recognized as a high quality stream which flows runs through the City of Cuyahoga Falls, eventually flowing through the Cuyahoga Valley National Park and empties into Lake Erie, and;

WHEREAS, the Cuyahoga River provides important environmental benefits and value to our community and our regional park resources, and;

WHEREAS, the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (OEPA) completed a Lower Cuyahoga River Total Maximum Daily Load (TMDL) in 2003, and;

WHEREAS, the TMDL identified the presence of low head dams in this area as the primary cause of impairment to aquatic life resources, and;

WHEREAS, the OEPA has been successful in bypassing the Kent Dam in 2004, removing the Munroe Falls Dam in 2005, and removing the Powerhouse and Sheraton Dams in Cuyahoga Falls in 2013, and;

WHEREAS, the removal of the Gorge Dam directly addresses the impact of flow alteration and will contribute to the restoration of riparian habitat and aquatic life communities in compliance with Ohio Water Quality and Biological Criteria.

Section 1. This Council hereby supports and agrees to participate in the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency's efforts to remove the Gorge Dam along the Cuyahoga River.
