7 A RESOLUTION TO ADOPT AND PARTICIPATE IN A  
8 MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN  
9 WITH THE COUNTY OF SUMMIT EMERGENCY  
10 MANAGEMENT AGENCY, AND DECLARING AN  
11 EMERGENCY.

12  
13 WHEREAS, there currently exists between the City of Cuyahoga Falls, Ohio and  
14 the County of Summit, Ohio, an agreement that the County through its Emergency  
15 Management Agency shall provide emergency management for the City in  
16 conjunction with a county-wide coordinated program; and

17  
18 WHEREAS, through this county-wide coordinated program, County of Summit  
19 Emergency Management Agency has developed a Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard  
20 Mitigation Plan that includes all hazards to which the County and its  
21 municipalities are susceptible as per Section 322 of the Robert T. Stafford Disaster  
22 Relief and Emergency Assistance Act, and:

24 WHEREAS, goals, objectives and strategies to mitigate against the hazards that  
25 have been identified in the County, including the City of Cuyahoga Falls, have been  
26 developed; and

27  
28 WHEREAS, mitigation measures for the City and surrounding areas have been  
29 analyzed and prioritized; and

31 WHEREAS, Summit County stakeholders have reviewed the Multi-  
32 Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan,

34 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga  
35 Falls, County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

36  
37 Section 1. This Council hereby adopts, and plans to implement the actions  
38 prescribed in, the County of Summit Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan,  
39 which is on file in the Office of the Director, County of Summit Emergency  
40 Management Agency.

42 Section 2. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances  
43 and resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and  
44 resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith  
45 and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

46  
47 Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council  
48 concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open  
49 meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any

50 committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the  
51 public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the  
52 Codified Ordinances.

54 Section 4. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure  
55 necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and  
56 welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it  
57 receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to  
58 Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and  
59 approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest  
60 period allowed by law.
