A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING SUPPORT FOR AND URGING PASSAGE OF ISSUE 19, THE WOODRIDGE LOCAL SCHOOL DISTRICT LEVY, AT THE GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON NOVEMBER 3, 2015, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Woodridge Local School District has caused a proposed tax levy to be placed on the November 3, 2015 general election ballot as Issue 19, and

WHEREAS, funds generated by the levy are necessary to provide for a new primary and intermediate school facility on the Quick Road campus, a new roof on the existing middle school and expanded classroom space, including a new gymnasium at the existing high school, and

WHEREAS, the campus setting will create cost savings and efficiencies, while making transportation easier for parents with students in multiple buildings, and

WHEREAS, the Woodridge Local School District has a tradition of being a small district with the ability to provide individual attention to the students and the updated facilities and increased space will allow the district to continue specialized learning for all students.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

The Council and Administration express their support for the Woodridge Local School District and urge the passage of Issue 19 at the November 3, 2015 general election.

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

This resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the Section 3. preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
