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8 A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC
9 SERVICE TO APPLY FOR AND ACCEPT FINANCIAL
10 ASSISTANCE IN THE FORM OF A GRANT OR LOAN FROM THE
11 OHIO PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION FOR REPLACEMENT OF
12 A 500,000 GALLON ELEVATED WATER TANK, AND
13 DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.
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15 WHEREAS, the Ohio Public Works Commission ("OPWC"), through its State Capital
16 Improvement Program and Local Transportation Improvement Program, provides financial
17 assistance to political subdivisions for capital improvements to public infrastructure; and
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19 WHEREAS, the City of Cuyahoga Falls has identified the need, plans for, and proposes a
20 capital improvement to public infrastructure, to wit: replacement of a 500,000 gallon
21 elevated water tank with a 500,000 gallon spheroid tank at Oak Park on Jefferson Avenue;
22 and
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24 WHEREAS, the infrastructure improvement is considered to be a priority need for the
25 community and is a qualified project under the OPWC program.
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27 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls,
28 County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:
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30 Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to apply for and accept
31 financial assistance in the form of a grant or loan from the Ohio Public Works Commission
32 for the purpose of supporting the capital improvement consisting of replacement of a
33 500,000 gallon elevated water tank with a 500,000 gallon spheroid tank at Oak Park on
34 Jefferson Avenue, by means of the State Capital Improvement Program (SCIP) and/or Local
35 Transportation Improvement Program (LTIP) administered by the Ohio Public Works
36 Commission.
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38 Section 2. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into agreements as
39 may be necessary to apply for and accept the financial assistance mentioned herein.
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41 Section 3. The Clerk is hereby directed to prepare and transmit a certified copy of this
42 Resolution to the Ohio Public Works Commission.
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44 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning
45 and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this
46 Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted
47 in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal
48 requirements, to the extent applicable, including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.


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Section 5. This resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
