A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING SUPPORT FOR AND URGING PASSAGE OF ISSUE 29, THE CUYAHOGA FALLS CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT LEVY, AT THE GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON NOVEMBER 7, 2017, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Cuyahoga Falls City School District has caused a proposed levy to be placed on the November 7, 2017 ballot as Issue 29; and

WHEREAS, the current aged school facilities are hazardous and inefficient and do not meet state minimum building standards; and

WHEREAS, costly, temporary fixes drain money from the classrooms without providing long term benefits; and

WHEREAS, funds generated by Issue 29 are necessary to provide for modern school facilities which are crucial for effective learning in today's society; and

WHEREAS, the sustained value and appeal of housing in communities is directly related to the success of the school districts.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

<u>Section 1</u>. The Council and Administration express their support for the Cuyahoga Falls City School District and urge the passage of Issue 29 at the November 7, 2017 general election.

Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

<u>Section 3</u>. This resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
