A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE AMOUNTS AND RATES OF TAXATION AS CERTIFIED BY THE SUMMIT COUNTY BUDGET COMMISSION, AUTHORIZING THE NECESSARY TAX LEVIES, CERTIFYING SUCH AUTHORIZATION TO THE COUNTY FISCAL OFFICER, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City, in accordance with the provisions of law, has previously filed Alternative Tax Budget Information with the Summit County Fiscal Officer for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2016; and

WHEREAS, on September 18, 2015 the Budget Commission of Summit County certified its action thereon to the City, together with an estimate by the County Fiscal Officer of the rate of each tax necessary to be levied by the City and what part thereof is without and what part thereof is within the Charter tax limitation,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. The amounts and rates of taxation as determined by the Budget Commission in its certification, attached hereto as Exhibit "A", are hereby accepted.

Section 2. There shall be and hereby is levied on the tax duplicate of the said City the rate of each tax necessary to be levied within and without the Charter limitation as follows:

Section 3. The Clerk of Council is authorized and directed to forward a certified copy of this resolution to the County Fiscal Officer.

Section 4. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 5. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

Section 6. This resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
