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7 A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC  
8 SERVICE TO APPLY FOR AND ACCEPT FINANCIAL  
9 ASSISTANCE IN THE FORM OF A GRANT OR LOAN FROM THE  
10 OHIO PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION FOR REPLACEMENT OF A  
11 10" SANITARY SEWER IN 18<sup>TH</sup> STREET, AND DECLARING AN  
12 EMERGENCY.

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14 WHEREAS, the Ohio Public Works Commission ("OPWC"), through its State Capital  
15 Improvement Program and Local Transportation Improvement Program, provides financial  
16 assistance to political subdivisions for capital improvements to public infrastructure; and  
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18 WHEREAS, the City of Cuyahoga Falls has identified the need, plans for, and proposes a  
19 capital improvement to public infrastructure, to wit: replacement of a 10" sanitary sewer  
20 with a 12" sanitary sewer, including all necessary appurtenances, in 18<sup>th</sup> Street between  
21 Ohio Avenue and Phelps Avenue; and  
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23 WHEREAS, the infrastructure improvement is considered to be a priority need for the  
24 community and is a qualified project under the OPWC program.  
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26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls,  
27 County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:  
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29 Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to apply for and accept  
30 financial assistance in the form of a grant or loan from the Ohio Public Works Commission  
31 for the purpose of supporting the capital improvement consisting of replacement of a 10"  
32 sanitary sewer with a 12" sanitary sewer, including all necessary appurtenances, in 18<sup>th</sup>  
33 Street between Ohio Avenue and Phelps Avenue, by means of the State Capital  
34 Improvement Program (SCIP) and/or Local Transportation Improvement Program (LTIP)  
35 administered by the Ohio Public Works Commission.  
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37 Section 2. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into agreements as  
38 may be necessary to apply for and accept the financial assistance mentioned herein.  
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40 Section 3. The Clerk is hereby directed to prepare and transmit a certified copy of this  
41 Resolution to the Ohio Public Works Commission.  
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43 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning  
44 and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this  
45 Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted  
46 in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal  
47 requirements, to the extent applicable, including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.  
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49        Section 5. This resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for  
50 the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of  
51 Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of  
52 two thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in  
53 force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect  
54 and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
