5 RESOLUTION NO. 9 - 2015

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7 A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC
8 SERVICE TO APPLY FOR AND ACCEPT A GRANT FROM THE
9 SUMMIT REWORKS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

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11 WHEREAS, the City of Cuyahoga Falls desires to implement and support new and existing
12 community recycling programs that assist the Summit ReWorks in meeting the goals and
13 objectives of the State of Ohio's Solid Waste Management Plan and the Summit ReWorks
14 approved Plan; and

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16 WHEREAS, the Summit ReWorks has developed the Community Recycling Access Grant (the
17 "Grant") to support projects which would sustain and increase recycling activities within Summit
18 County; and

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20 WHEREAS, the City of Cuyahoga Falls is eligible to apply to the Summit ReWorks for the
21 Grant which will further the mutual goals of the City and the Summit ReWorks in sustaining and
22 increasing recycling activities within Summit County;

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24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County
25 of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

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27 Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to apply for and accept the
28 Community Recycling Access Grant from the Summit ReWorks, on behalf of the City of Cuyahoga
29 Falls, for the purposes set forth in the grant application and grant agreement.

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31 Section 2. The Clerk is hereby directed to send the Summit ReWorks a copy of this
32 resolution to the attention of Program Coordinator, The Summit ReWorks, 12 East Exchange
33 Street, Third Floor, Akron, Ohio 44308.

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35 Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and
36 relating to the passage of this resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that
37 all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were
38 in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107
39 of the Codified Ordinances.

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41 Section 4. This resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the
42 preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga
43 Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the
44 members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its
45 passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest
46 period allowed by law.
