16 WHEREAS, Article I, Section 2 of the City Charter, adopted pursuant to Art.
17 XVIII, Sections 3 and 7 of the Ohio Constitution, authorizes this Council to make
18 exception to the competitive bidding procedures set forth in the Revised Code; and
19

20 WHEREAS, lines are used for emergencies and/or alarms for various City
21 properties; and
22

23 WHEREAS, the City obtained quotes and AT&T was able to provide the
24 necessary services at the best cost.
25

26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga
27 Falls, County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:
28

29 Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a
30 contract or contracts, without competitive bidding, with AT&T for Plain Old
31 Telephone Service (POTS) lines which support alarms, elevators and dispatch
32 non-emergency numbers throughout the City.
33

34 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make
35 payment for same from funds properly appropriated to the various departments
36 of the City for these purposes, according to an apportionment of costs as between
37 the departments.
38

39 Section 3. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and
40 resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and
41 resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith
42 and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

14 WHEREAS, Council passed Ordinance 49-2022 for the purchase of Motorola
15 radios for use in the Fire and Police Departments; and
16

17 WHEREAS, this is the second phase of a mandatory upgrade to be completed
18 by 2025; and
19

20 WHEREAS, the City will receive a credit to replace non-upgrade eligible APX
21 Radios; and
22

23 WHEREAS, pricing for this contract was obtained from a statewide
24 consortium, eliminating the need for additional competitive bidding.
25

26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga
27 Falls, County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

29 Section 1. The Director of Public Safety is hereby authorized to enter into a
30 contract or contracts, according to law, with Motorola, Inc. for the purchase of

34 payment for same from the Capital Projects Fund, line item Capital Outlay.

10 WATER TREATMENT PLANT IMPROVEMENTS, AND

13 WHEREAS, the existing softener building and ion exchange softening system
14 at the Water Treatment Plant is 87 years old, inefficient, and in need of
15 replacement; and

16
17 WHEREAS, the current open-air brine treatment system is inefficient, open to
18 the elements, and in need of replacement and updating; and

19
20 WHEREAS, optimizing the use of salt brine will minimize chloride discharge
21 to the Cuyahoga River, which is regulated under the City’s existing National
22 Pollutant Discharge Elimination System Permit.

23
24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga
25 Falls, County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

26
27 Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a
28 contract or contracts with CTI Engineers, Inc. for Water Treatment Plant
29 improvements.

31 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized to make payment for
32 the same from the Water Fund, line item Capital Outlay.

33

17 WHEREAS, Karvo Paving Co is currently under contract for the ODOT Widening and
18 Improvement Project in the same location; and
19

20 WHEREAS, work is being completed during current roadway work, so as to alleviate
21 future disturbances in the new road surface; and
22

23 WHEREAS, a new water main will provide water to a currently isolated area for future
24 development; and
25

26 WHEREAS, an additional water main is needed to provide improved circulation and
27 pressure regulation within the City’s existing water system.

7 A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE MONTH OF MAY 2023 AS
8 MENTAL HEALTH AWARENESS MONTH IN THE CITY OF
9 CUYAHOGA FALLS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

10
11 WHEREAS, people across the United States experience mental health conditions
12 that impact their individual health and wellbeing as well as their relationship with the
13 community; and

14
15 WHEREAS, Mental Health Awareness Month, observed since 1949, has served as a
16 vehicle for awareness, education, and advocacy around mental health and provides an
17 opportunity for residents to highlight the difficulties of the past few years; and

18
19 WHEREAS, the City of Cuyahoga Falls in collaboration with its partners is committed
20 to improving the mental health of residents by leading and collaborating on initiatives
21 and programs that provide education, events, and services involving mental health; and

22
23 WHEREAS, Change Direction is a campaign by the Alcohol, Drug Addiction, and
24 Mental Health Services (ADM) Board that aims to change the culture around mental
25 health in Summit County and the City of Cuyahoga Falls and improve the emotional
26 well-being of residents, and provides an opportunity for community members and
27 organizations to get involved in fostering mental wellness; and

28
29 WHEREAS, other programs like Mental Health First Aid training offered by
30 organizations such as Love Akron provide other opportunities for residents to learn and
31 raise awareness about mental health; and

32
33 WHEREAS, Summit County is currently participating in Upward Mobility, an Urban
34 Institute project focused on combating poverty, and one of this project's priorities is to
35 increase the mental wellness of Summit County by leveraging stakeholders like the ADM
36 Board and National Alliance on Mental Illness to improve the livelihoods of residents;
37 and

38
39 WHEREAS, supporting and educating the community on mental health and wellness
40 is crucial to preventing crises and fostering a healthy, thriving City and County; and

41
42 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent
43 information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the City of Cuyahoga Falls
44 that May 2023 be declared Mental Health Awareness Month in the City of Cuyahoga
45 Falls.

46
47 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls,
48 County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

49 Section 1. The month of May 2023 is hereby declared Mental Health Awareness
50 Month in the City of Cuyahoga Falls.

7 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE RENAMING OF
8 PORTAGE TRAIL EAST TO EAST PORTAGE TRAIL, AND
9 PORTAGE TRAIL EXTENSION WEST TO WEST PORTAGE
10 TRAIL, WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF CUYAHOGA FALLS,
11 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.
12

13 WHEREAS, the same road within the City of Cuyahoga Falls is known as Portage
14 Trail, Portage Trail East, and Portage Trail Extension West; and
15

16 WHEREAS, this condition of multiple street names for the same road may cause
17 delays for responding safety forces to the correct locations using computer aided
18 dispatch systems; and
19

20 WHEREAS, it is the desire of this Council to promote uniformity of street names
21 within the City of Cuyahoga Falls.
22

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls,
24 County of Summit, and State of Ohio:
25

26 Section 1. That the name of Portage Trail East, from the thalweg of the Cuyahoga
27 River to High Street, be changed to East Portage Trail.
28

29 Section 2. That the name of Portage Trail Extension West, within the city limits of
30 Cuyahoga Falls, be changed to West Portage Trail.
31

32 Section 3. That the remainder of Portage Trail within the city limits of Cuyahoga
33 Falls, remain as Portage Trail.
34

35 Section 4. That the City Engineer be and is hereby authorized and directed to make
36 changes on the official map of the City of Cuyahoga Falls.
37

38 Section 5. Any other ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and
39 resolutions inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed, but any
40 ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously
41 been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.
42

43 Section 6. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council

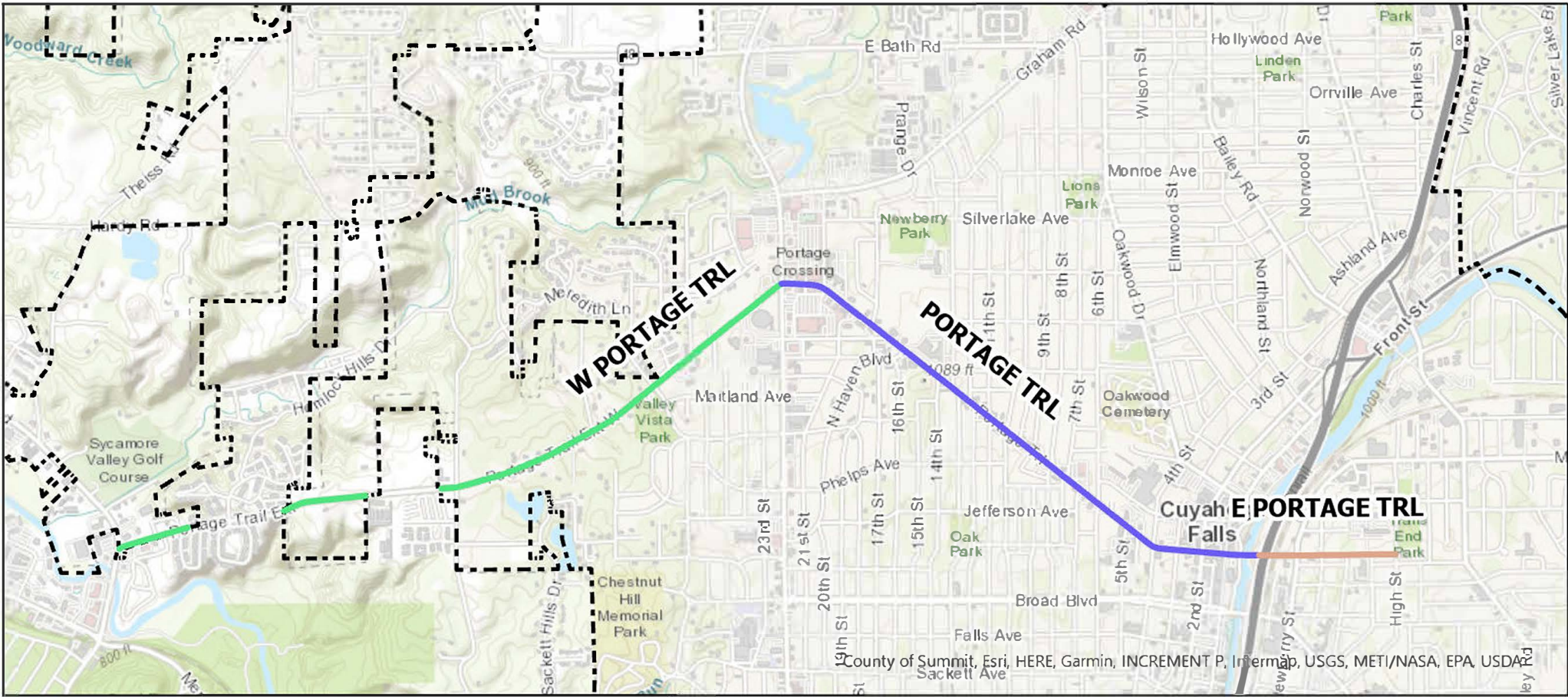

PROPOSED RENAMING OF PORTAGE TRAIL
