17 Section 1. The Director of Community Development is hereby authorized to enter

19 records imaging/scanning project.

21 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized to make payment for same

7 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC  
8 SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS,  
9 AFTER PUBLICLY ADVERTISING FOR BIDS, FOR CONCRETE  
10 PAVEMENT REPAIRS TO VARIOUS STREETS, AND  
11 DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

13 BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and  
14 State of Ohio:

15  
16 Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract  
17 or contracts, after publicly advertising for bids, for concrete pavement repairs to various  
18 streets.

19  
20 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make payment  
21 for same from the Capital Projects Fund, line item Capital Outlay.

22  
23 Section 3. Any other ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and  
24 resolutions inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed, but any ordinances  
25 and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed  
26 are hereby ratified and confirmed.

27  
28 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning  
29 and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this  
30 Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted  
31 in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal  
32 requirements, to the extent applicable, including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

33  
34 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for  
35 the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of  
36 Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof and provided it receives the affirmative vote of  
37 two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in  
38 force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take  
39 effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.

7 A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO APPLY FOR  
8 AND ACCEPT FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE IN THE FORM OF A  
9 GRANT OR LOAN FROM THE OHIO PUBLIC WORKS  
10 COMMISSION FOR UPGRADES TO THE BAILEY ROAD  
11 BOOSTER PUMP STATION, AND DECLARING AN  
12 EMERGENCY.

13  
14 WHEREAS, the Ohio Public Works Commission (“OPWC”), through its State Capital  
15 Improvement Program and Local Transportation Improvement Program, provides  
16 financial assistance to political subdivisions for capital improvements to public  
17 infrastructure; and

18  
19 WHEREAS, the City of Cuyahoga Falls has identified the need, plans for, and proposes  
20 a capital improvement to public infrastructure, to wit: upgrades to the Bailey Road  
21 booster pump station; and

22  
23 WHEREAS, the infrastructure improvement hereinabove described is considered to be  
24 a priority need for the community and is a qualified project under the OPWC program.

25  
26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls,  
27 County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

28  
29 Section 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to apply for and accept financial  
30 assistance in the form of a grant or loan from the Ohio Public Commission for the  
31 purpose of supporting the capital improvement consisting of upgrades to the Bailey  
32 Road booster pump station, by means of the State Capital Improvement Program and/or  
33 Local Transportation Improvement Program administered by the Ohio Public Works  
34 Commission.

35  
36 Section 2. The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into agreements as may be  
37 necessary to apply for and accept the financial assistance mentioned herein.

38  
39 Section 3. The Clerk of Council is hereby directed to prepare and transmit a certified  
40 copy of this resolution to the Ohio Public Works Commission.

41  
42 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council  
43 concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open  
44 meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its  
45 committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in  
46 compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent applicable, including Chapter 107  
47 of the Codified Ordinances.

49 Section 5. This resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary

7 A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE DEVELOPMENT  
8 OF A WELCOMING WORKFORCE COALITION IN THE  
9 CITY OF CUYAHOGA FALLS, AND DECLARING AN  
10 EMERGENCY.

11  
12 WHEREAS, it is predicted that by the year 2030, there will be a national  
13 labor shortage of 80.1 million jobs due to retirement, career change, and  
14 individuals choosing to leave the labor market; and

15  
16 WHEREAS, the United States is experiencing a decline in population  
17 growth that will make it difficult to fill these predicted labor shortages; and

18  
19 WHEREAS, the Fund for our Economic Future has predicted that  
20 Northeast Ohio will experience a labor shortage that is 13% higher than the  
21 national average; and

22  
23 WHEREAS, international newcomers have and will continue to be the main  
24 source of population growth across the country and throughout the State of  
25 Ohio; and

26  
27 WHEREAS, the City of Cuyahoga Falls recognizes the importance of  
28 attracting and retaining international newcomers to its community and creating  
29 a strategic plan to provide them with the resources and support necessary to  
30 become engaged members of its local workforce; and

31  
32 WHEREAS, Council previously authorized funding for the City of  
33 Cuyahoga Falls to hire Rise Together, LLC as a consultant to develop a creative  
34 strategic plan to address the City’s workforce issues; and

35  
36 WHEREAS, as a result and with the consultant’s assistance, the City of  
37 Cuyahoga Falls has developed a Welcoming Workforce Coalition comprised of  
38 business leaders, elected officials, faith community members, international  
39 newcomers, nonprofit organizations, and young professionals that will develop  
40 the strategic plan that will both create a sense of belonging for its international  
41 newcomer population and propose systematic changes to the workforce designed  
42 to attract and retain international newcomers.

43  
44 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of  
45 Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit, and State of Ohio, that:

46        Section 1. Council hereby declares its support for the development of a  
47 Welcoming Workforce Coalition in the City of Cuyahoga Falls to address the  
48 necessary systematic changes needed to attract and retain international  
49 newcomers to its community and workforce.  
50

51        Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council  
52 and concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in  
53 an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of  
54 its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the  
55 public, in compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent applicable,  
56 including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.  
57

58        Section 3. This resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure  
59 necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience  
60 and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and
