ORDINANCE NO. 100 - 2022

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE TRAFFIC CONTROL FILE BY PROVIDING FOR INSTALLATION OF VARIOUS TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, site-specific traffic control regulations of the City are established and maintained in the "Traffic Control File," a document established and maintained by the Chief of Police pursuant to Chapter 305 of the Codified Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, Section 305.02 of said Chapter requires that amendments to the Traffic Control File be made only through legislation passed by City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit, and State of Ohio, that:

<u>Section 1</u>. Upon the recommendation of the Traffic Committee, the Traffic Control File is hereby amended as follows:

- 1. Remove signage including any prohibitions relating to the permanently closed St. Joseph School on Broad Boulevard, 2nd Street, 3rd Street and Falls Avenue
- 2. Remove the "No Parking" signs on the north side of Falls Avenue between 4th Street and 5th Street, and replace with "No parking; school drop-off/pick-up only" signage
- 3. Remove the "No Parking" signs on 5th Street and replace with "School Bus Parking Only" signage from the intersection of 5th Street and Falls Avenue and 180 feet north

<u>Section 2</u>. The Chief of Police is hereby authorized and directed to note in the Traffic Control File the proper legends.

<u>Section 3</u>. The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to cause the installation or removal of the proper signage reflecting the above amendments.

<u>Section 4</u>. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed but any ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not been previously repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent applicable, including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

Section 6. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
