7 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 123-2021 AUTHORIZING THE
8 DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR
9 CONTRACTS, ACCORDING TO LAW, FOR THE PURCHASE OF ANNUAL
10 REQUIREMENTS OF CERTAIN SERVICES, MATERIALS, AND SUPPLIES
11 FOR USE BY THE GARAGE DIVISION DURING 2022, AND DECLARING
12 AN EMERGENCY.
13

14 BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and State of Ohio,
15 that:

16
17 Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or contracts,
18 according to law, for the purchase of certain materials, supplies and services for use by the Garage Division
19 during 2022:

21 Fuel
22 Tires
23 Repairs
24 Parts

26 Section 2. The authorized aggregate expenditure limit authorized by Ordinance 123-2021 is increased
27 from \$1,662,000 to \$1,812,000.

29 Section 3. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for same from
30 the Garage Fund, line item Other Operations.
31


32 Section 4. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent
33 herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions
34 not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.
35

36 Section 5. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to
37 the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations
38 of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to
39 the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.
40

41 Section 6. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation
42 of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the
43 inhabitants thereof for the reason that the supplies and services are necessary for the daily functioning of
44 the Municipal Garage, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or
45 appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the
46 Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
