7 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF
8 PUBLIC SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR
9 CONTRACTS, WITHOUT COMPETITIVE BIDDING,
10 WITH SSOE GROUP FOR ENGINEERING SERVICES
11 RELATED TO UPGRADES AT THE CF1 AND CF2
12 GENERATORS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

14 WHEREAS, the Electric Division desires to make upgrades to the CF1 and
15 CF2 generators to increase reliability; and

16
17 WHEREAS, the Electric Division has been working with SSOE Group and they
18 are most familiar with the Division’s goals for this specific project.

19
20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga
21 Falls, County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

22
23 Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a
24 contract or contracts, without competitive bidding, with SSOE Group for
25 engineering services related to upgrades at the CF1 and CF2 generators.

26
27 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized to make payment for
28 the same from the Electric Fund, line item Capital Outlay.

29
30 Section 3. Any ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and
31 resolutions inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed, but any
32 ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not
33 previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

34
35 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council
36 concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an
37 open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any
38 of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to
39 the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent applicable,
40 including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

41
42 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure
43 necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience
44 and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and
45 provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or
46 appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its
47 passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force
48 at the earliest period allowed by law.
