12.2 - 2021

WHEREAS, the City Garage has endured unforeseeable cost increases during 2021, necessitating an increase in its annual requirements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or contracts, according to law, for the purchase of certain materials, supplies and services for use by the Garage Division during 2021:

> Fue1 Tires Repairs Parts

Section 2. The authorized aggregate expenditure limit authorized by Ordinance 100-2020 is increased from \$1,416,000 to \$1,548,000.

Section 3. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for same from the Garage Fund, line item Other Operations.

Section 4. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 5. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.
