## 133 - 2022 ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PARKS AND RECREATION BOARD TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS WITH CARRIER CORPORATION FOR THE PURCHASE OF A 250-TON CHILLER UNIT TO BE INSTALLED AT THE NATATORIUM, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the purchase by contract of the equipment, services, materials or supplies identified herein is through participation in a contract between the vendor and Sourcewell, a cooperative purchasing group, and is thus exempt from competitive bidding requirements pursuant to Ohio Revised Code §125.04; and

. WHEREAS, the chiller unit at the Natatorium is now over 18 years old and reaching the effective life cycle; and

WHEREAS, the replacement of the chiller unit, will allow the Natatorium to modernize and replace a failing system.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. The Parks and Recreation Board is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or contracts with Carrier Corporation for the purchase of a 250-ton chiller unit to be installed at the Natatorium.

Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized to make payment for same from Leisure Time Fund, line item Capital Outlay.

Section 3. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent applicable, including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

<u>Section 5</u>. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the
