ORDINANCE NO. 141 - 2022

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 82-1987 ESTABLISHING POLICIES AND PROCEDURES WITHIN THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF CUYAHOGA FALLS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit, and State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. Ordinance 82-1987, Section 8, shall be amended as follows:

## Section 8. Permissible Placement.

The ERAC may in its discretion place a new regular employee in any step up to and including PCI Two, upon application of his the new regular employee's superior if it is the committee's determination that said employee possesses such qualifications, experience or education as to qualify him the new regular employee for such step. Upon recommendation of the superior, the ERAC may award the new regular employee years of private work experience time commensurate with their relevant work history in the same manner that public sector employees are awarded service credit for vacation accrual. The ERAC may also award the new regular employee vacation time in the first year based on the recommendation of the superior, but not to exceed the awarded experience applicable schedule. Any awarded vacation time cannot be sold or carried over into the next calendar year. It is the intention of this provision that the new regular employee shall progress along the salary and vacation schedule from the starting point approved by ERAC. This applies to vacation and salary only. All other benefits will follow applicable City policy and practice.

<u>Section 2.</u> Any ordinances and resolutions, or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements to the extent applicable, including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

Section 4. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall
