Upon the recommendation of the Traffic Committee, the Traffic 25 Control File is hereby amended as follows: 26 27 1. Request to replace the 4-way stop with a traffic signal at the intersection of 2nd Street and Northland St. 28 29 30 2. Request to prohibit left turn movements into and out of the 31 Target/Staples, and Applebees/Ollie's, drives from Howe Avenue 32 by making these areas a right turn only. 33 Section 2. The Chief of Police is hereby authorized and directed to note in 34 35 the Traffic Control File the proper legends. 36 37 Section 3. The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to cause the 38 installation or removal of the proper signage reflecting the above amendments. 39 40 Section 4. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances 41 and resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed but any ordinances 42 and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent 43 herewith and which have not been previously repealed are hereby ratified and 44 confirmed. 45 46 Section 5. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council 47 concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any 48

of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to

the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances. Section 6. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
