ORDINANCE NO. 3 - 202

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT AGREEMENT WITH R2K CONTRACTING, INC., IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$67,921.00 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City receives Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds from the Department of Housing and Urban Development; and

WHEREAS, CDBG funds can be used to assist with Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) compliant renovations and modifications of public facilities; and

WHEREAS, renovations and modifications of the first floor restrooms at the Quirk Cultural Center, located at 1201 Grant Avenue, Cuyahoga Falls, Ohio 44223, are necessary to meet ADA compliance standards; and

WHEREAS, the City of Cuyahoga Falls wishes to enter into a CDBG Agreement with R2K Contracting, Inc., in an amount not to exceed \$67,921.00 for ADA-compliant renovations and modifications to the first-floor restrooms at Quirk Cultural Center, located at 1201 Grant Avenue, Cuyahoga Falls, Ohio 44223.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit, and State of Ohio that:

<u>Section 1.</u> The Mayor is authorized to enter into a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) agreement with R2K Contracting, Inc., in an amount not to exceed \$67,921.00 for Americans with Disabilities Act compliant renovations and modifications to the first-floor restrooms at Quirk Cultural Center, located at 1201 Grant Avenue, Cuyahoga Falls, Ohio 44223.

Section 2. The Director of Finance is authorized to increase appropriations in CDBG, fund line item Capital Outlay by \$67,921 and decrease appropriations in CDBG Fund, line item Other Operations by \$67,921 and make payment for the same from CDBG Fund, line item Capital Outlay.

Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council and concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent applicable, including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

<u>Section 4.</u> This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided that it receives the
