5 ORDINANCE NO. 34 - 2022

7 AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A
8 CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS, WITHOUT COMPETITIVE BIDDING, WITH
9 SKYLIFT INC. FOR THE PURCHASE OF MINI-DERRICK EQUIPMENT,
10 APPURTENANCES, AND SERVICES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

12 WHEREAS, the Electrical Division has many rear lot pole lines that can only be accessed by a mini-
13 derrick machine for pole removal and setting; and

14
15 WHEREAS, the Electrical Division already has a Skylift mini-derrick and requires a similar second unit
16 for the crews to use; and

17
18 WHEREAS, Skylift Inc. is the sole source provider of this equipment and related appurtenances, and
19 services.

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit,
22 and State of Ohio, that:

24 Section 1. The Director Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or contracts with
25 Skylift Inc. for the purchase of mini-derrick equipment, appurtenances, and services for use by the
26 Electrical Division.

27
28 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized to make payment for same out of the Electric
29 Fund, line item Capital Outlay.

30
31 Section 3. Any ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent
32 herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which
33 have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

34
35 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
36 to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all
37 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in
38 meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent applicable, including
39 Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

40
41 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the
42 preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and
43 the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected
44 or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by
45 the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
