ordinance no. 36 - 2022

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH DANT CLAYTON FOR THE REPLACEMENT OF SEATING IN THE DOWNTOWN AMPHITHEATER, LOCATED AT 2085 FRONT STREET, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$58,900.00 AND MAKING THE NECESSARY APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE SAME, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Cuyahoga Falls published a joint Request for Quotes for the Cuyahoga Falls Downtown Amphitheater Seating Project; and

WHEREAS, the seating modules in the Downtown Amphitheater, located at 2085 Front Street, are over 18 years old and are reaching the end of their effective life cycle; and

WHEREAS, the City receives Community Development Block Grant ("CDBG") funds from the Department of Housing and Urban Development; and

WHEREAS, CDBG funds can be used to assist with ADA compliant renovations and modifications of public facilities and a portion of the new seating will be ADA compliant; and

WHEREAS, the City of Cuyahoga Falls wishes to enter into an agreement with Dant Clayton, in an amount not to exceed \$58,900.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. The Mayor is authorized to enter into an Agreement with Dant Clayton in an amount not to exceed \$58,900.00 for the replacement of seating in the Downtown Amphitheater, located at 2085 Front Street.

Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized to increase appropriations in the Community Development Block Grant Fund, CDBG, line item Capital Outlay and reduce appropriations in the Community Development Block Grant Fund, CDBG, line item Other Operations by \$31,650.00.

Section 3. Furthermore, the Director of Finance is authorized to make payment from the Recreation Levy Fund, Parks and Recreation Department, line item Capital Outlay in the amount of \$27,250.00, and from the Community Development Block Grant Fund, CDBG, line item Other Operations in the amount of \$31,650.00.

Section 4. The Mayor, Director of Finance, Director of Community Development, Director of Law, and any other public officials, individually and/or collectively as may be appropriate, are authorized to prepare and execute such other documents and do all other things as are necessary or incidental to carrying out the intent and/or requirements of this legislation.

Section 5. Any ordinance or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

<u>Section 6.</u> It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent applicable, including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

Section 7. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary of the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience, and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
