AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A REAL ESTATE PURCHASE AGREEMENT WITH RIVER RUN COMMONS, LLC., ACCORDING TO LAW, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$55,000.00, UTILIZING COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FUNDS, FOR THE PURCHASE OF CERTAIN PROPERTY KNOWN AS V/L GERMAINE STREET, CUYAHOGA FALLS, OHIO 44221 (PARCEL 02-00381) AND A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH HABITAT FOR HUMANITY OF SUMMIT COUNTY, FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A SINGLE-FAMILY RESIDENTIAL UNIT, FOR A LOW-TO-MODERATE INCOME FAMILY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Cuyahoga Falls is the recipient of Community Development Block Grant ("CDBG") funds through the Department of Housing and Urban Development; and

WHEREAS, CDBG funds are to be utilized to achieve decent housing, a suitable living environment, and expanded economic opportunities for low-to-moderate income individuals; and

WHEREAS, CDBG funds can be utilized to acquire property for the future construction of housing for low-to-moderate income individuals; and

WHEREAS, the City of Cuyahoga Falls wishes to purchase the real property known as V/L Germaine Street, Cuyahoga Falls, Ohio 44221, Parcel 02-00381, from River Run Commons, LLC in an amount not to exceed \$55,000.00, with CDBG funds.

WHEREAS, the City of Cuyahoga Falls wishes to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with Habitat for Humanity of Summit County for the construction of a single-family residential unit to be built on the aforementioned real property and sold to a low-to-moderate income family; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

<u>Section 1.</u> The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a real estate purchase agreement with River Run Commons, LLC., for the purchase of real property known as V/L Germaine Street, Cuyahoga Falls, Ohio 44221, Parcel 02-00381, with CDBG funds, in an amount not to exceed \$55,000.00.

<u>Section 2.</u> The Director of Finance is hereby authorized to increase appropriations in the CDBG Fund, line item Capital Outlay by \$55,000.00 and decrease appropriations in the CDBG Fund, line item Other Operations by \$55,000.00 and to make payment for same from the CDBG Fund, line item Capital Outlay.

<u>Section 3.</u> The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with Habitat of Humanity of Summit County for the construction of a single-family residential unit that will be sold to a low-to-moderate income family.

Section 4. This Council further authorizes the Mayor, Director of Finance, Director of Community Development, Director of Law, and any other public officials, individually and/or
