ORDINANCE NO. 42 - 2021

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF AKRON. OHIO, TO SHARE THE COST OF ENGINEERING AND CONSTRUCTION FOR THE RESURFACING OF PORTIONS OF RIVERVIEW ROAD, AKRON-PENINSULA ROAD, SMITH ROAD AND PORTAGE TRAIL, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, it is necessary to have a cooperation agreement between the cities of Cuyahoga Falls and Akron to make application for Akron Metropolitan Area Transportation Study Federal Surface Transportation Block Grant Funds for the resurfacing of portions of Riverview Road, Akron-Peninsula Road, Smith Road and Portage Trail; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to share the cost of the resurfacing of portions of Riverview Road, Akron-Peninsula Road, Smith Road and Portage Trail between the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the City of Akron.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and State of Ohio:

Section 1. The Director of Public Service be and hereby is authorized to enter into a cooperative agreement with the City of Akron to share the cost of engineering and construction for the resurfacing of portions of Riverview Road, Akron-Peninsula Road, Smith Road and Portage Trail.

Section 2. The Director of Finance be and hereby is authorized to make payment for same from the Capital Projects Fund, line item Capital Outlay.

Section 3. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its Committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent applicable, including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor, otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
