ORDINANCE NO. 43 - 2022

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS. WITHOUT COMPETITIVE BIDDING, FOR THE PURCHASE OF SERVICES, MATERIALS, SUPPLIES, AND EQUIPMENT FOR USE IN THE ELECTRICAL DIVISION IN 2022, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, City departments and divisions must purchase services, materials, supplies, and equipment throughout the year to operate effectively; and

WHEREAS, the public bidding process can slow the procurement of goods and services necessary to City operations; and

WHEREAS, with some vendors, although no specific expenditure for their services, materials, supplies, and equipment are expected to exceed the competitive bidding amount threshold individually, collectively these costs are projected to exceed the competitive bidding limit.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls. County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or contracts, without competitive bidding, with the vendors listed below, for the purchase of the materials, supplies, and equipment listed in Exhibit A for use in the Electrical Division in 2022:

- Anixter Inc.
- Brownstown Electric Supply Co.
- DECO Supply Company Inc.
- Electric Research and Manufacturing Cooperative, Inc. (ERMCO)
- Main Street Lighting
- Power Line Supply Co.
- Professional Electric Products Company (PEPCO)
- Stella-Jones Corp.

Section 2. Notwithstanding as an exception to Section 181.06 of the Codified Ordinances, Electrical Division expenditures made under the contracts authorized by this ordinance shall not exceed, in the aggregate, the budgets listed in Exhibit A without further consent of City Council by ordinance.

Section 3. The Director of Finance is hereby directed to make payment for same out of the Electric Fund, line items Other Operations and Capital Outlay, as indicated in Exhibit A.

<u>Section 4.</u> Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 5. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent applicable, including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

<u>Section 6.</u> This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
