7 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC
8 SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THOMPSON
9 ELECTRIC, INC. FOR THE PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF A
10 TRAFFIC SIGNAL AT THE INTERSECTION OF SECOND STREET
11 AND NORTHLAND AVENUE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

13 BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and State
14 of Ohio, that:

16 Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with
17 Thompson Electric Inc., for the purchase and installation of a traffic signal at the intersection of
18 Second Street and Northland Avenue.


20 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for
21 same from the Capital Projects Fund, line item Capital Outlay.

23 Section 3. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions
24 inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions or portions of
25 ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been
26 repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

28 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and
29 relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and
30 that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal
31 action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including
32 Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

34 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the
35 preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga
36 Falls, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or
37 appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and
38 approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed
39 by law.
