8 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE TRAFFIC CONTROL
9 FILE BY PROVIDING FOR INSTALLATION OF
10 VARIOUS TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES, AND
11 DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

13 WHEREAS, site-specific traffic control regulations of the City are established
14 and maintained in the "Traffic Control File," a document established and
15 maintained by the Chief of Police pursuant to Chapter 305 of the Codified
16 Ordinances; and

17
18 WHEREAS, Section 305.02 of said Chapter requires that amendments to the
19 Traffic Control File be made only through legislation passed by City Council.

20
21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga
22 Falls, County of Summit, and State of Ohio, that:

23
24 Section 1. Upon the recommendation of the Traffic Committee, the Traffic
25 Control File is hereby amended as follows:

- 26
- 27 1. Request to prohibit parking on the south side of Orrville Avenue from
- 28 the corner of Kilarney Street to 120 feet west of Kilarney Street.
- 29
- 30 2. Request to include in the File previously installed "no parking" signs
- 31 on the even side of 12th Street between Washington Avenue and Silver
- 32 Lake Avenue.
- 33

34 Section 2. The Chief of Police is hereby authorized and directed to note in
35 the Traffic Control File the proper legends.

36
37 Section 3. The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to cause the
38 installation or removal of the proper signage reflecting the above amendments.

39
40 Section 4. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances
41 and resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed but any ordinances
42 and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent
43 herewith and which have not been previously repealed are hereby ratified and
44 confirmed.

45
46 Section 5. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council
47 concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an
48 open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any
49 of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to

50 the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of
51 the Codified Ordinances.

52

53 Section 6. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure
54 necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience
55 and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof and
56 provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or
57 appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its
58 passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force
59 at the earliest period allowed by law.
