58 ORDINANCE NO. - 2022

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 131-2021 TO HIRE AN ADDITIONAL SECRETARY I AND ASSIGN THE POSITION TO THE APPROPRIATE PAY GRADE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT BETWEEN AMERICAN FEDERATION OF STATE, COUNTY AND MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES LOCAL 2662 AND THE CITY OF CUYAHOGA FALLS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Police Department requires an additional employee to aid in the fulfillment of public records; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor, as Director of Public Safety, and the Police Chief desire to add an additional Secretary I to the Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. The position of Secretary I is hereby amended and placed in the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees bargaining unit pay grade of A04.

Section 2. Subject to the sufficiency of annual or supplemental appropriations for personal services in the Police Department, the Police Department shall be composed of the following officers and other personnel (new text double underlined; deleted text in strikethrough):

Officers:

- 1 Chief
- 2 Captains
- 4 Lieutenants
- 10 Sergeants
- 57 Patrol Officers

Other Personnel:

- 1 Secretary II
- 23 Secretary I
- 1 Juvenile Diversion Caseworker

This section shall not limit the Police Chief from hiring additional personnel in the Police Department to replace anticipated vacancies where such vacancy is known and such overlap does not exceed thirty (30) days.

Section 3. Any ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance/resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent applicable, including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.
